This area of the wine list is to assist all of those interested in trying a new wine, something different or just to gain knowledge on a certain wine. I have chosen some wines from every section, in different price points and in different styles that hopefully will peak your interest. I will give quick tasting notes and reasons on why I chose the wine to be on the list.

Many of the wines on our list are unique and unknown; we choose wines that are quality focused instead of quantity focused. However there are a few well known wines on the list for your convenience. I implore you to venture out and try something new, there is no risk in buying wine here we just want you to have the most enjoyable evening possible and a great bottle of wine is known to do just that.

Fess Parker, Viognier, Santa Barbara County

Beautiful wine with classic floral tones with mineral and tropical fruit backbone.

Artesa, Chardonnay Carneros

Full bodied and rich flavors of fruits, vanilla, cream and oak. This is a great to try instead of Simi. The characteristics are similar but this is more complex and not much more in price.

Baileyana, Chardonnay Edna Valley

I LOVE THIS WINE!

This is an exceptional bottle of wine great depth and balance. Try this by the bottle instead of a few glasses of another chardonnay. I think you will love it as well.

St Innocent "Anden Vineyard" Willamette Valley

This is just one of those wines that make you pause and say WOW! Known for their Pinot Noir, but this wine is gorgeous and elegant

Joseph Drouhin, Pouilly Fuisse

Elegance is the first word that comes to mind when this wine hits your palate. It is gorgeous with classic profile of the regions; slate, flint, lemon & lime with balanced tones of oak.

Torbreck "Woodcutters", Semillion, Barossa Valley

I love Semillon when it is done right and this is done right. It is lemony fresh and crisp with a touch of oak age which rounds this wine perfectly.

Truchard, Roussanne, Carneros

Roussanne is a varietal that I know to Rhone France and is commonly blended. As a standalone varietal expect crisp acidity, tropical fruits and spice.

Michel Schlumberger, Melor, Dry Creek

Elegant & Complex

This is an awesome merlot. Absolutely beautiful, balanced minerals and fruits with an old world feel with a touch of new world fruit.

Carr, Grenache, Santa Barbara County

Only 176 cases produced this is an amazing wine. Full bodied with great depth, fruits, oak and earth. One of my favorite wines in the price range and style.

Casa Silva "5 Generacion" Cab/Carmenere/ PV, Chile

Rich & Complex

Rich and velvety with soft tannins and flavors of black fruits and chocolate.

Carmigliano, Rosso di Montalcino, Italy

Great Value!

Known as a baby brunello, because the grapes are sourced from the same vineyards so the taste is similar but not as complex.

Ciacci Piccolomini, Sangiovese Blend, Tuscany

This Wine is Phenomenal

This is another great value. The body is juicy and complex with herbs, spice, fruits & earth

Conde de San Cristobal, Tempranillo/Cab

Ribera del Duero

This is a beautiful old world wine. Rich flavors of earth with a touch of new world fruit, impeccable balance and depth.

Neyers Pato Vineyard Contra Costa

Only 1000 Cases Great Value

This is a great wine to try if you were considering Renwood. Limited case production, depth and complexity, black fruits and pepper.

Lone Madrone, Syrah, Paso Robles

265 cases produced Simply Amazing!

This is easily one of my favorite wines on the whole list. Elegant, complex, great depth, like a painter on your tongue.

Ici\La-Bas "Les Reveles", Anderson Valley

Made by Jim Clendenden, who is a well known and talented wine maker. This wine is complex and flavorful.

Carr, Pinot Noir, Santa Rita Hills

Single Vineyard

This is a massive pinot noir. The body is medium but the flavor is focus and balanced.

Chehalem Three Vineyards, Pinot Noir

A twist of old world and new world. Juicy tannins and fruits with the elegance of earth and terrior.

Ancien "Toyon Farm" Carneros Single Vineyard

This low production wine is has beautiful juicy sweet fruits interlaced with vanilla oak.

Halleck Vineyard "3 Sons", Russian River Valley

My favorite Pinot Right Now

Very aromatic and elegant. Great focused flavors of fruits, spice and earth.

Chateau Belgrave, Haut Medoc

Highly Rated

Supple flavors of black fruits and balanced tones of oak and vegetation. Silky tannins.

Paul Hobbs, "Crossbarn" Cabernet, Napa

Great Balance & Depth

This is an almost perfect cab. Black fruits, earth, oak, licorice, chocolate, raspberries...

Naughty "Racy" Cab/Cab Franc/ Zin, Napa

596 Cases

This is a killer wine, made by one of Napas best, Steve Reynolds. It is full of rich red fruits and a touch of earth and herbs.
